Spend a day focusing on marine biology and studying the eelgrass and sand dollar beds in Netarts Bay, Oregon by boat. Our boat is a ex. military/coastguard rigid inflatable boat. It is a commercial quality craft and because of it's stability we have never had anyone get seasick on it! Generally trips run from 10am to 5pm. The exact timing of each trip depends on the tides.

Check Dates and Times

If bringing a group you can always reach out to see if another time works.

Upon arrival we will dawn our lifejackets and board the boat. First we zip up and down the bay, periodically stopping to learn what makes this particular well mixed estuary so special. Most bays are salt wedge estuaries, Netarts Bay is one of our very favorite places as there are only a couple bodies of water like it on the west coast. The diversity above and below the water is stunning and points clearly to God, our Creator!
